Jubilee Committee Charter is to:

- make neither a Profit nor Loss
- play Bridge and Socialise
- give former and current members registration priority
- hold all play in the Club, capping registrations if necessary
- Cater the Dinner off site

- Tournament principles

Restrictions

- Play is capped at 34 tables (136 players) per session
- Dinner seats are capped at the venue capacity of 178

Tournament Principles

- The Jubilee Tournament is rated as NZBridge Domestic, and "C" points will be awarded.
- 4 separate sessions of Play. You may play in any or all 4 sessions, with the same or different partners. The Committee will assist finding a partner for you if you so wish.
- Prizes are awarded to the best session play partnership in 3 categories Open, Intermediate and Junior. The highest-ranking player defines a category. (eg a Senior-Junior partnership will rank as Senior.) NB: Retired former Senior Players without a NZBridge ranking may be assigned a Tournament Ranking by the Director.
- Only one session prize is awarded to any one individual. (eg If you win a session prize in session 1, that is your lot for the tournament.)
- Dinner is widely open to players, and partners,
- Transport or Ride Sharing can be arranged for the Dinner for those who don't drive in the night.
